Saint Faustina (Helen Kowalska) was born in Poland on 25th August, 1905. She came from a very poor family. She died on 5th October 1938. When she was almost twenty, she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. In the 1930's Sister Faustina received from the Lord a message of mercy that she was told to spread throughout the world. This is now being done. She was canonised a saint in the year 2000. Her diary **Divine Mercy in my Soul** has become the handbook of devotion to The Divine Mercy.
