**EUCCHARISTIC CONGRESS BELL:** Will be visiting our diocese as part of its nationwide pilgrimage between the 18<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> May. It will be collected from Manorhamilton parish at the parish boundary on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> May evening and carried to St. Aidan's Church, Kinlough when it will remain overnight. Then on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> at 12 noon it will be carried to Tullaghan where it will be passed on to Elphin diocese. The Congress Bell has its origins in the Dominican Convent in Portstewart in Co. Derry and it was used to ring in the Jubilee Year 2000 in Glendalough Co. Wicklow. The bell, a reminder of the tradition of St. Patrick's Bell, represents the call to faith, to prayer, to conversion and the vocation to service and to mission. The journey of the bell will help to raise awareness of the Eucharistic Congress in June 2012 and encourage people to become involved in the event itself.
