### **When will we be using the New Edition of the Roman Missal?**

The texts of the Third Edition of the Roman Missal are being introduced in two phases to avoid too much change happening at once. From the second Sunday of September we will begin to use the new translations of the people's prayers and responses at Mass, for example the Confiteor, the Gloria and the Creed. These texts will be in missalettes and on congregational cards when people come to Mass. From the First Sunday of Advent the new translations of the prayers of the Mass that are led by the priest will come into use for example, the Collect or opening prayer and the Eucharistic Prayer. The Third Edition of the Roman Missal, therefore, will be fully implemented on the First Sunday of Advent.
