It was great to see such a large crowd of pilgrims from the diocese on Tuesday 12th and at the Statio Orbis in Croke Park on Sunday 17th. Many other individual pilgrims from the diocese attended the Congress on the other days as well. Some told me that they had to come back each day as they found it such a positive and uplifting experience. All agreed that the liturgies were beautiful despite the frequent showers, the prayer space on oasis of calm in a busy RDS and the workshops, if you were lucky enough to get a seat, were thought provoking and challenging.
