Divine Mercy Sunday

In St. Aidan's Church Kinlough with confessions from 2.30 p.m. on this Sunday 27th.

This year, 2014 is a very special year with the canonization of Pope John Paul 11 and Pope John XX111. Pope John Paul was a great influence on the development and promotion of Divine mercy. His deep awareness of the life and works of St. Faustina and his knowledge of the difficulties in the early days of the message being accepted brought him very close to the Divine Mercy spirituality. Canonising St. Faustina in year 2000 was one of the highlights of his papacy. He died on the vigil of divine Mercy and now few years later, is being canonised on the Feast of Divine Mercy which is a great tribute to him. Pope John Paul is in fact very much part of Divine mercy story.
