Ash Wednesday & The Ashes

This coming Wednesday 18th February is Ash Wednesday and the first day of the season of Lent. There will be ashes distributed at all the Masses on that day. Note the times of the Masses. The ashes are a grim reminder of our bodily mortality. 'Dust thou are and unto dust thou shalt return'. Lent challenges us to reflect on where our life is heading. Taking ashes on the forehead is a sign that one is going to do something special for Lent: maybe self-denial, daily Mass, more time for prayer, being more helpful at home, contributing to the Trócaire Box for the poor.

ASH WEDNESDAY 18TH FEB.: Mass as usual for Wednesdays except that there will be also an evening Mass in Kinlough at 8.00 p.m.

ASH WEDNESDAY: This Wednesday 18th February and it is a day of Fast and Abstinence.

FASTING – the amount of food we eat is considerably reduced. Those between 18 and 60 are obliged.

ABSTINENCE – we give up a particular kind of food or drink or form of amusement. Those over 14 are obliged.

TRÓCAIRE: Please pick up your Trócaire Package containing your Trócaire Box at the Church door.

Place in a prominent place in your home and encourage family members to contribute to it during Lent. You will be asked to convert your contribution into notes in the special green envelope in your packet of envelopes for taking up in the Offertory Procession on Holy Thursday.
