**EU ANTI-TRAFFICKING DAY:** October 18<sup>th</sup> has been designated EU Anti-Trafficking Day. One might have hoped on this, the 10<sup>th</sup> Anti-Trafficking Day, that we would not be facing the reality that, rather than decreasing, human trafficking is actually on the increase. *Act to Prevent Trafficking (APT)*, a faith-based organisation, working with more than seventy groups in the *Turn off the Red Light* campaign, is calling on the Government to enact the 2015 Bill to criminalise demand for sexual services – as has already been done in Northern Ireland. What can you, your parish, your community do? Take action by praying that this huge injustice may be eliminated, by raising awareness of the facts of human trafficking and by calling on your TDs to lobby the Dail to ensure that this Bill becomes law.
