Sunday 9th:

Passion (Palm Sunday) Blessing of Palms and reading of Passion at all masses including Vigil mass.

Tuesday 11th:

Preparation for Easter. In Saint Aidan's Church Kinlough for the whole Parish at 8.00 p.m. Penitential service with Confession, Blessing with oil and Benediction. There will be a number of priests present. It is hoped you will be able to spend this time in preparation for Easter.

Holy Thursday 13th:

Mass of the Lord's Supper in Saint Aidan's Church, Kinlough for the whole parish at 8.00 p.m. Please convert your Trócaire contribution to notes and put in appropriate Yellow envelope for taking up at the offertory. Eucharistic Adoration after mass until 12 midnight for the whole parish. Please make an effort to attend. No other Eucharistic Adoration in the parish during Holy Week or week after Easter.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY 23rd April: St. Aidan's, Kinlough, at 11.00 a.m.

From St. Faustina's Diary it is clear that this Octave Day of Easter is chosen by Christ as a day of extraordinary graces – a complete outpouring of His mercy upon all who approach Him with great trust and expectant faith. Jesus told Saint Faustina "The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of Mercy".

Divine Mercy is now a public feast of the church by an official instruction given by Pope John Paul II on 5th May, 2000.

To prepare for this great Feast of Mercy and to obtain all the graces offered it is necessary to comply with the following:

- The Feast should be preceded by a Novena of Chaplets to the Divine Mercy beginning on Good Friday and finishing nine days later on the Saturday.
- Sermon on Divine Mercy.
- Contemplating on this day, the mystery of Redemption.
- Image of Divine Mercy blessed and publicly venerated.
- Confession before the Feast. (Penitential service Tuesday 11th at 8 p.m.)
- Holy Communion on the day.
- An act of mercy should take place in our lives, as part of our preparation for the feast. We should be merciful to others in our words, deeds and prayers.

The preceding novena will be recited in Saint Aidan's Church, Kinlough, starting Good Friday after the 3 p.m. devotions and at 3 p.m. on all the following days up to and including Sunday 23rd April. Celebration of Divine Mercy will be part of the 11.00 a.m. mass on Sunday 23rd April. People who wish to take part in the novena can do so in the church at the Divine mercy image or privately in their own homes. Leaflets containing this novena are available at the church door. You can tune into this each day on FM107.
