You will get your envelopes for the coming year this week. If not please let us know. If you haven't been using the envelope system up to now we ask you to do so from now on for the following reasons:

1. We can acknowledge your contributions.
2. No matter which church you go to your envelope contribution will be returned to your own church which is important for the upkeep of your local church.
3. We can avail of the 31% Tax Refund which is available on all contributions from tax payers using the proper envelopes. This is an easy way of getting extra income & it would be a shame to miss out on this. Even those who pay half yearly or yearly should use one of these proper envelopes.

PS. From 1st January use only the new 2018 envelopes. To use old ones leads to mistakes and difficulty in recording.
