**What is the Eight Amendment?**

The wording of the Eight Amendment reads as follows:

“The State acknowledges the right to life of the unborn and, with due regard to the equal right to life of the mother; guarantees in its laws to respect, and, as far as practicable, by its laws to defend and vindicate that right”.

This is a declaration to respect, defend and vindicate the equal right to life of a mother and her unborn child. It enshrines in Irish law a deep conviction that every human life is precious, equal and worth cherishing.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS:** You should have received an acknowledgement of your envelope collections for the past year recently. Please check & let us know if you detect any error.

**DIOCESAN FINANCIAL PROCEDURES:** The Irish Episcopal Council Diocesan Financial Procedures state clearly that any envelopes received from an outside parish should be recorded as received and returned to the home parish without any unnecessary delay. This is to ensure that the donation is received by the home parish. There is a moral and legal obligation to do this. Not to meet this requirement would mean that the acknowledgement we issue to our parishioners, and to which they are entitled, would be inaccurate. Furthermore it would mean that our parishioner's tax refund to our parish would be lessened or maybe even lost completely where the lower limit of €250 donation is not reached. Please check that your envelopes are being returned to our parish.
